What's a Covenant?





- Things God promises to do
 - Noah, Abraham, Moses, Mary
 - "New Covenant": Jesus Christ
- Things God's people promise to do in response
 - 10 Commandments, David & Kings
 - "New Covenant": Jesus Christ
- Always in that order

A Covenant with whom? The Creed(s)

Renunciations & Affirmations

- Part of Baptism liturgy (BCP 302) and Confirmation / Reception liturgy
- Part of ancient Examination before Baptism
 - Renunciation of Satan [and sin]
 - Recitation of the Creed

Communal Act – together as the whole Body of the faithful

The Promises

- Celebrant Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of the bread, and in the prayers?
- People I will, with God's help.
- Celebrant Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord?
- People I will, with God's help.

The Promises

Celebrant	Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ?
People	I will, with God's help.
Celebrant	Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as yourself?
People	I will, with God's help.
Celebrant	Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being?
People	I will, with God's help.

Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?















How do you repent and return?

- Identify failings
 - Private prayer (conscience)
 - Community
- Repent
 - Corporate confession
 - Private confession (reconciliation)
- Return
 - Restitution
 - Feel Grace















How do you tell the story by word and example?

• Learn the story

- Church, community, and your own life
- When have you received Grace?
- Tell the Story of God in Christ by word
 - Share about St. George's
 - Tell your own story
 - Were you surprised by the way we do church here? Tell others!
- Tell the Story by example
